# Gregg's Good News

What did you experience during the week of Prayer and Fasting? I find myself remembering the points of prayer numerous times during the day. I like that. Focus on a few points of prayer seems to increase my persistence. It will be intriguing to watch as God continues to answer our prayers. I expect one outcome to be moves in the direction of "Changing the World by Communicating Christ: From Corvallis to the Continents"

I also am caught off guard by how difficult and uncomfortable it has been to let go of some routine practices. This week provides an important reminder of the value of the Spirit fruit called "self-control."

One day this week, I was reading Jeremiah 29; a letter Jeremiah wrote to the exiles in Babylon. The letter moves two directions. First, Jeremiah counsels the exiles to settle down and get on with life in their current situation. Second, Jeremiah offers these encouraging words from the Lord, "I know the plans I have for you, plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future. . . You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart."

Sometimes we find ourselves in seasons of adversity like the exiles in Babylon. In the midst of it, we have to keep getting out of bed, stepping into the actions of life and putting one foot in front of the other. The good news is that it is always appropriate to put our hope in God. And because we trust Him above all else, we seek him. This week of prayer and fasting was a great reminder not only to seek God, but to trust the present AND the future to Him.
