0000 We often look to the Sermon on the Mount as a great summary of how to live life as Jesus intended. I find it intriguing that in my earliest days as a Christian, I learned the importance of keeping one's fasting a secret. But I never felt any nudge from that teaching that fasting was a practice that I ought to pursue. Yet Matt. 6:16-18 begins with the phrase, "When you fast' Rather than condemning the practice of fasting, Jesus wanted his disciples to go ahead and fast but with proper motives. We fast to free up time and attention for prayer.

I am hoping you will join with me for a season of Fasting and Prayer during Feb. 15-21. You may choose to fast from food, media, Facebook, TV or something else for all or part of the week. Let's devote to prayer around 3 topics. 1. Many women are pregnant at this time or just had babies. Let us pray that those children and all of our children grow up to be World Changers as they Communicate Christ. I hope you see how this will help God's focus for the world come to fruition.

2. Let us pray that each one of us may find our role/action in the body and do it so Christ is effectively communicated here. 3. Let us pray for God's healing to continually embrace Ezra Parker.
