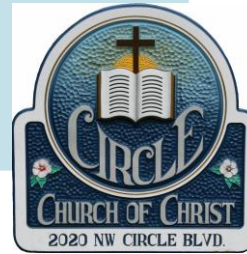

# Gregg's Good News

As I consider a focused vision God has in mind for Circle Church of Christ, I distill it with the following words:

- 1. Many women are pregnant at this time or just had babies. Let us pray that those children and all of our children grow up to be World Changers as they Communicate Christ.
- 2. Let us pray that each one of us may find our role/action in the body and do it so Christ is effectively communicated here.
- 3. Let us pray for God’s healing to continually embrace Ezra Parker.
