# Gregg's Good News

Have you ever noticed how much we learn about Jesus' mindset and methods at those moments when someone interrupts him?

A leper breaks into Jesus' day. Jesus stops to touch him, heal him and send him to the priests so he can be formally welcomed back into the mainstream. A weeping woman breaks into Jesus' meal with a man of note. Jesus stops to welcome her and remind the self-righteous banquet sponsor that great love grows from great forgiveness.

The examples are numerous. I've learned from Jesus not to stay so focused on "my schedule and plans" that I fail to encounter the moments of God moving around me.

When I planned out the week, I did not factor in all of the conversations the week would include. But one of those "interruptions" reminded me how much other members of this body love family members that are being strangled by evil. And it ultimately lightened my load.

I planned to go to a prayer meeting, but I did not plan for the long conversation afterward. The prayer itself centered around a transition God is working for "Friends of the Family Ministry." It was a great reminder of God's ability to solve dilemmas in creative ways. But my plan was clear: Get out of there quickly and get back to the growing to do list. Then came the "interruption." In the next few minutes I received encouragement, insight and another friend praying for a concern.

What's the point? Stop dashing through life with your cell phone in front of your face. Stop viewing the moments when your child needs you as annoyances. Stop staring past people who are trying to break through. Jesus knew that interruptions were opportunities. That's the point.
