

In the future, I hope you will become a person who makes every Sunday morning an appointment with God and his **people.** There is a positive, cumulative effect that comes from being exposed to worship and Bible teaching over the long run. Singing the songs, saying the prayers, and listening to a reading from the Word of God are all ways God uses to shape us. In addition, all the conversations with Christians have power to direct our steps.

Let me draw an analogy that may be all too familiar to Teenagers. As our baby teeth come out and are replaced with the second set, they don't always fit very well. Perhaps there isn't enough room for all the teeth, so they are uncomfortably crowded. What is the solution? The word most of us don't want to hear or pay for is "braces." The appliances do their job by applying steady pressure for months. Eventually the ongoing influence results in teeth moving to a better place.

During the process, the movement is often undiscernible. But change is happening whether we are aware or not. Sunday after Sunday exposure to the influence of God may not seem like much in the short run. But in fact, that influence is even stronger than a mouth full of wires. It doesn't stop at simply realigning the teeth, it reshapes the whole "me."

Allowing God to straighten up my life is more important because it remedies things that are out of line in the very core of my heart. And when God makes us right within, the outside actions tend to be right as well. Or said another way, it's a change as remarkable as rising from a dead way of behaving to live a new life.
