Some aspects of Christian thought seem to eventually emerge at the extreme point. For example, if we look back several centuries, most people did not have access to a Bible. Whatever the church said was viewed as the final word in matters of faith regardless of the actual validity or error of the "church" opinion. The church and church membership were of ultimate importance if the people wanted to have access to God.

When the Bible became much more readily available, people began to question some of the convictions proclaimed by the "church" in the past. In addition, over time, people began to feel more boldness to believe that church membership alone was not the only aspect of access to God. Eventually, there began to be a strong emphasis on each and every individual having a "personal relationship" with God.

Perhaps we shouldn't be surprised that now the "personal relationship" idea has been overdone in the minds and lives of many people. Some carry the sense that so long as they have some "spirituality," which is loosely interpreted as any kind of awareness or pursuit of the "other-worldly," they are just fine. Even many who would style themselves as Christian, see no value in church membership. Others go so far as to see no value in church at all. So long as "Me and God" are somewhat connected, they perceive they've got the Christian thing and eternal life in the bag.

Somewhere between the idea that Christianity is all church membership without personal relationship and Christianity is all personal relationship without church membership is the stance that God truly expects.

This morning, we are beginning a season of church life centered around "I Am A Church Member." I hope this is a great time of reflection and renewal for all of us as we seek balance in life with God and his people.
