Consequently, we keep the mindset that "Success is Sending." It is great that some graduates are able to stay with us. But rather than face each Spring with sadness over those who do depart, it is preferable to focus on the upside to their move. Today calls back to remembrance the vision,

"Changing the World by Communicating Christ: From Corvallis to the Continents."



Tuesday-Saturday morning I will be traveling or in Searcy, Arkansas. For several years, I have been part of a training team that prepares people to be Vocational Missionaries in East Asia. Last year, our own Maria Gomes was one of the learners. This Fall she will move to Asia to serve.

While the annual trip does take me away from Corvallis, I like to think of it as this congregation loaning me out for a few days to do work that grows the broader kingdom of God. The leader of the training team tells me that he looked at numerous Christian universities and other settings, but he could not find a person who is able to share the "doing it/taking it to the street" insights to Mission Theology and Methods that I can. I get to prepare people beyond Circle church to pursue the same vision I've mentioned above that we are pursuing. And I learn from the other trainers as well.

So, I invite you to pray for me. I will be doing 5 formal teaching sessions as well as panels and numerous conversations with the students. Pray for good health, rest at night and words from God.



What if Christians intentionally gathered in a public place to sing and share a meal? What if people of God sought to mix with neighbors on their neighbors' turf? More to come in the weeks ahead.
