

If you examine the Mission Methods of Paul, you will discover that sometimes he preaches at the synagogue. On another occasion he preaches in Athens at a public gathering. But when he and the mission team first came to Phillipi, they went to the riverside. One of the women they met was named Lydia. And before long, she was baptized. That intrigues me. Paul goes where people are gathered and makes a connection for God.

I invite you to join me in taking the church outside the building. On three Sunday's this Summer: June 26, July 24 and Aug. 28; we are gathering at Cloverland Park at 5:00 pm.

After some singing, prayer and Lord's Supper, we will eat together picnic style. Then, everyone is free to go play and meet other people who are already at the park.

Ride your bikes, bring your kids and a sandwich or something simple to eat. A soccer ball or Frisbee could also be a good item to attract a few folks to join us.

The organizers will bring a few chairs. But if you have a camp chair, it would be good to bring it along.

Here's another idea: If you have a friend you've been wanting to introduce to church people, invite them to come and join the picnic.
