September always marks the "crank-up" of several aspects of life in this congregation. For us, the "New Year" doesn't start on Jan.1st, but on Sept. 1.

During Sept., Wednesday evenings were used to sharpen our evangelistic edge and "ReVISION" church life. I trust that you will start using the insights gathered at those presentations in your Life group and in your conversations with people. Listen well for the real concerns people voice, and speak gospel to those needs.

On Sunday nights, we reviewed a few of the Wed. PM points. But the primary purpose was to create 4 blocks of time dedicated to prayer. It seems a foolish exercise to launch so many things in the life of the church if we do not commit them to God and call out in prayer for His work.

Let's not lose that healthy emphasis on prayer. For the next few weeks, I plan to offer several points of prayer that we can unite in on various days of the week.

Monday: Pray for the current and future President and Vice-President to hear and submit to God's leadership.

Tuesday: Pray that all Senators and Representatives will be shaped by God and legislate in light of His shaping.

Wednesday: Pray for all in law enforcement and all who interact with representatives of the law; that all would have best decision making in every situation and all would be safe.

Thursday: Pray for all men and women in the Armed Forces. Pray that God would provide them strength and protection.

Friday: Pray that this church and every church will deepen commitment to prayer and persist in praying.
