Have you ever wondered why the Sanhedrin wanted Jesus dead? Why were they so violently against a simple carpenter? In our CITE class on Matthew we looked at the history that led up to Jesus' life. In 586BC the temple was destroyed and the Jews were exiled. The prophets during that time were proclaiming that it was because they hadn't followed the Law of Moses or the Torah. When the Jews were allowed to return by Cyrus, they focused on following Torah and the traditions as a way to love God and connect to His blessings. The people were so focused on doing Torah so that they could show God how much they loved Him and be blessed that they missed the love of God in Jesus Christ when he was standing right in front of them. This makes me pause and wonder sometimes, am I missing Jesus in my desire to do good things or rest or anything else in life? It's a good reflection point that can realign my heart with God's heart.

This is some of what we are learning in CITE this term. It will be a great study of Matthew. You can still audit the class and learn with our other 8 students if you are interested. Class meets on Thursday from 5:15-8pm at UCC. If you can't make this term, consider taking the ACTS class in the Spring Term which begins the first week of April.
