Gregg's Good News

Over the years, I have experienced differing opinions about "worship." Including a question as basic as "when do we worship?"

Some place all the weight on Rom. 12:1, "offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God—this is your spiritual act of worship." The opinion was that all of our worship takes place in the things that we do during the week. Our Sunday meeting existed solely to "spur one another on towards love and good deeds." In other words, the Sunday gathering was totally about the horizontal dimension of Christianity, "one another."

On the far opposite end of the continuum, the Sunday gathering is only about the vertical dimension of "me and God." The Sunday gathering is seen as having one purpose: creating an environment where I, in individual isolation from anyone else who is present, can have a "wow" moment of encountering God. While I assume there is a hope that the encounter alters day to day behavior, the one another aspect of gathering is deemphasized.

A healthy view of worship is somewhere in between those two extremes. Last Summer, I preached a series inviting us to grow in our sense of showing up with the expectation of meeting and honoring God because we tend too much towards our assembly only emphasizing "one another."

Those of us who are worship planners are increasingly attempting to make sure a "thread" of thought pervades the Sunday assembly so we can grow in the "vertical" dimension. Please have your ears and heart open to that thread. If you do, hopefully it will increase your sense that we are assembling in the presence of God: the Holy God who leads us to fall on our face in front of him. And when you truly encounter God, you will be a 24/7 living sacrifice.
