Last week I wrote a reminder for all of us to **do two** things as we assemble to worship.

1. Expect to meet with God.

2. Listen for the theme that is threaded through the Scripture reading, songs and the sermon.

One thing that will help all of us move in those directions begins with the decision to view the word "worship" as a verb. For those who haven't set foot in English class for a while, verbs are action words.

If you look around the room, you might see a person who "comes to church," sits down and waits for the people on the stage to do and say the right things so that person can "worship." This is often the person who is frustrated if the songs weren't to their liking or the sermon said more to someone else.

In contrast, worship as a verb lays the responsibility on each person who is present.

When you offer your voice to God in song, your heart to God in communion, and your mind to God for His teachingyou quickly discover that the assembly is richer than it ever was before.
