Gregg's Good News

On Sunday, May 7, we placed about \$8,000 in Milton Jones hands. With the matching funds available to Christian Relief Fund, that doubled to \$16,000.

The cost to drill a well in Kenya is \$ 10,000. Consequently, our offering essentially made it possible for 1 ½ new wells to be drilled.

Here's the update: Those wells are now operational!

Go and take a look at the information on the kiosk/spin tower. You will see two posters called "CRF Well Report."

One well is in Elamach, Kenya. Along with the well, CRF is teaching the people about irrigation and the Living Water—Jesus Christ.

The other well is in Lomorgete, Kenya. Local residents there proclaimed, "Now we truly believe that faith can move mountains."

As I see the pictures and hear the response of the people we served, it reminds me of II Cor. 9:12-15. This service that you perform is not only supplying the needs of the Lord's people but is also overflowing in many expressions of thanks to God. ¹³ Because of the service by which you have proved yourselves, others will praise God for the obedience that accompanies your confession of the gospel of Christ, and for your generosity in sharing with them and with everyone else. ¹⁴ And in their prayers for you their hearts will go out to you, because of the surpassing grace God has given you. ¹⁵ Thanks be to God for his indescribable gift!
