# Gregg's Good News

It doesn't take long for every conversation this week to turn to the same topic: "It's really hot!" Even though I am a guy who is hard-wired to like the warmer days, I have to agree, "It's hot."

Now if the heat isn't enough to catch our attention, there is a second prevalent conversation topic as well: "It's really smoky!" Between a forest fire near Mt. Jefferson, fires in Washington and another in British Columbia, the valley does feel like sitting 2 inches away from a campfire.

The smoke makes eyes watery. The heat makes the underarms watery. (I hope that is a gel enough way to say that.)

I note two primary responses to this week of hot weather and heavy smoke. For some people, it becomes a focus of their thoughts and conversation as well as the shaper of all they do. A second response appears to be just going about business as usual as much as possible. I tend to fit more in this group. (Truth be told, the two responses are probably determined in large part by access to air conditioning and whether you are a hot weather guy like me or a cool weather gal.)

In preaching, I have been leading us in a study of the "Kindness and Sternness of God." Today, we come to a foundational response to the reality of God's nature: Persevere. Life comes with ups and downs, joys and sorrows, seasons of smiles and seasons of sorrows. One primary way to make it through is to set our hearts and minds on things above. Because in one sense, your life is already there with Christ. (Col. 3:1-4),. And ultimately, you will be with Him forever.

Back to the world of heat and smoke. Even while living one day at a time, I persevere with the knowledge that one day—it will be over.
