Gregg's Good News

Of late, each day brings a new revelation of a person in power approaching, touching or exploiting another person sexually. In the process, the victims are revealing their residual pain caused by such evil.

Such behavior must <u>never</u> exist in the church. Sex is a good, God-designed aspect of life that belongs in and enhances marriage. Outside that relationship, it is out of bounds precisely because it can be damaging.

Paul counsels his young, single associate Timothy with these words. "Do not rebuke an older man harshly, but exhort him as if he were your father. Treat younger men as brothers, older women as mothers, and younger women as sisters, with absolute purity." (I Tim. 5:1-2) Paul's description of church as family reminds us to keep the same boundaries in the church that exist in healthy families.

If there is to be a positive outcome to this season of revealing, it must be a strong warning to those tempted to exploit and assistance for people who have been victims.

- 1. To avoid crossing a boundary in the way you view or touch others, look back to the instructions for Timothy.
- 2. If you are currently or have been a victim of inappropriate touch, speak to a trusted church member or leader. Assistance is available.
