

# Gregg's Good News

A good step for all of us to take in this new year is to increase the level of reverence in our Sunday morning assembly. Here's a dictionary definition for reverence: "a feeling of profound awe and respect and often of love; veneration." The definition itself suggests ways to prepare for worship.

- 1. Read a Psalm or consider a story from Scripture that once again leads you to recognize how far beyond us God truly is. Consider his power, his majesty, his works and the feeling of awe will increase.
- 2. Respect will increase as you recall how seriously God acted when His people defied or abandoned Him. After Israel built and bowed to the golden calf idol, about 3,000 were put to the sword by the Levites.
- 3. Consider the incredible gift God has given you—relationship with Him. But never forget that gift came at a very high cost, the blood of God's own Son, Jesus. Such remarkable love invites you to love in return.
- 4. Various actions are intended to show humility and veneration of God. We stand for Scripture reading, bow heads or kneel for a prayer and ignore the bulletin during Lord's Supper to honor Almighty God.

Those are places to start on the inside to increase the sense of reverence at our assembly. But visible acts also matter.

- 1. Seek your seat before 10:30 to quiet your heart and seek intimacy with God.
- 2. Take care of physical needs (rest room, get the last cup of coffee) during the break.
- 3. If church feels boring, stay seated and read a great Bible story rather than going for a walk.


Question: Does your behavior at the assembly communicate reverence of God?
