Gregg's Good News

I Cor. 14 centers on the aspects of a healthy assembly. An assembly that results in the "strengthening of the church." (14:26)

I've often noted I Cor. 14:24-25 as evidence that an effective assembly also has an evangelistic component. As prophecy goes on, the unbeliever has an experience: "the secrets of his heart will be laid bare. So he will fall down and worship God, exclaiming, 'God is really among you!'"

Recently, I shared that verse with a brother and his response struck me as very insightful. He said, "It's the wow factor." I knew immediately what he was getting at. There are some assemblies that have "it." Not easy to define, not easy to create, but the assembly breaks through to your heart in a life changing way that leaves you aware you have been in the presence of God. That "God is really among you."

I don't know all the factors behind the "wow factor," but these will make a difference.

- 1. The context of I Cor. 14 extols the value of speaking intelligibly. Offering instruction that listeners can understand.
- 2. That calls every person who plays a public role in the assembly to prepare well. Not only to speak intelligibly, but in a way that shows spiritual preparation. People who have already been in the presence of God are more apt to shine that God to others.
- 3. We usually lack an intelligible start to our assemblies. When noise from the foyer and back of the Aud. competes with the song leader, it is confusing. To the unbeliever, it looks like disorganization at least; and irreverence at worst.
- 4. If every member of the assembly comes to see the show, the experience will be no better than the best performance of the public servants. But if every member of the assembly comes to encounter God, and help others encounter God; the "wow factor" will occur more frequently.
