Ethics is how we approach the world. Sometimes it's about following rules. Sometimes we do things based on the consequences. Sometimes we do things based on who we are. Does prayer have a place in ethics? Does prayer affect what we do or who we are? For some I think prayer is a should. Like a requirement to slug through each day. "I should pray before bed and meals and I should pray for so and so." This sounds like a chore? So how do we grow a vibrant praver?

I think we start with what is prayer. Is it a one way relationship where you tell God a bunch of stuff, ask for stuff and sign off? That sounds like a chore. What if prayer was communication about what you are doing together? You are sharing Jesus with a coworker so you ask for wisdom and confidence. You are giving more than you have in the past and you pray for trust. You are stepping into a new role at church and ask God to walk with you. Prayer becomes what we do with God. Just like any other relationship, the more we do together with God the more vibrant our prayer becomes.
