The Winter Paralympics are currently in progress in South Korea. I recently saw a very intriguing event. It is a skiing race, perhaps "Giant Slalom," for women who have sight impairment.

Two people go down the ski course at once. The sighted person stays some 10-15 yards in front of the competitor. The sighted person goes over the terrain first, shouting various instructions throughout the process. In addition, the sighted person in the lead often wears garments that will be visible to the competitor following behind. When the medals are awarded, both people stand together to rejoice.

This morning, that made me consider Hebrews 12:2. "Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God." The Revised Standard Version, calls Jesus, "the *pioneer* and perfecter of our faith."

Just as the skier with sight limitations fixes her eyes on the person ahead; so too, we fix our eyes on Jesus. He has already been on the track, so the instructions he shouts to us are the right guidance. And when it is time to receive the crown of life, we will all rejoice together.
