Gregg's Good News

Towards the end of Acts, Paul defends himself in front of several political officials. One man, Festus, is quite perplexed by the controversy between Paul and the Jewish leadership. Eventually, Festus sums up his understanding of the problem as "some points of dispute with him about their own religion and about a dead man named Jesus who Paul claimed was alive."

On this day of remembering the Resurrection, Festus' assessment of "a dead man named Jesus who Paul claimed was alive," seems like a shallow understanding. But it raises the question, "What is so important about some dead man named Jesus that Christians claim is alive?"

To begin with, Jesus is more than just another dead man. And resurrection offers the primary proof of Jesus' unique identity. Rom. 1:3-4 speaks of Jesus as a descendant of David and Son of God. Jesus' human genealogy is important because it means Jesus is from the correct lineage to allow him to be Messiah or King of Kings. Jesus' identity as Son of God demands that humans listen to him and treat him with all the dignity that belongs to God himself. That is why we speak of "Jesus Christ our Lord."

Understanding the unique identity of Jesus adds to the meaning of his resurrection for the rest of us. Humanity can now trust that a final resurrection is in the future for all people. I Cor. 15:20 reminds us, "But Christ has indeed been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep." Jesus was the first of many who will raise from the dead. So, the fact of Jesus' resurrection becomes a point of solid comfort whenever we encounter the death of a loved one or contemplate our own future.

Jesus: More than a dead *man*. More than just *alive*. Jesus resurrected from the dead.
