Gregg's Good News

Scanning the headlines of Yahoo News, the following headline caught my attention: "Cashing In On the Church: The Richest Mega-Pastors In America."

I Cor. 9:14 states, "the Lord has commanded that those who preach the gospel should receive their living from the gospel." But those "pastors" who enjoy extravagant lifestyles at the expense of the church are NOT living in line with that Scripture.

Of greater interest to me is the fact that such an article would even appear. It demonstrates a major shift in the culture around us. At one point in time, people in ministry were viewed as honorable people. That has changed, in no small part, due to "pastors" who are money-grubbers and flagrant examples of immoral behavior.

The other reality is that public critique of Christians is more common than in the recent past. The "new atheism" prompts some people to view religion as the problem behind conflicts in the world. Falsehoods continually repeated like, "there is no historical evidence for Jesus outside the Bible," are increasingly viewed as fact.

So, how should we respond? I Peter 3:15-17 and 2:15-24 offer helpful insights.

- 1. Be prepared to be a truth teller. That may include agreeing when wrong examples of Christian behavior are voiced. Wrong is wrong even when practiced by a "pastor."
- 2. Have enough knowledge that you can correct the falsehoods.
- 3. Live a holy life that demonstrates the critics view of all Christians is not valid.
- 4. Never quit confessing "Jesus is Lord."
- 5. Make sure that any suffering you endure is a result of doing good, not a result of ungodly life.

Jackson had some great words about our Spring Break Mission Trip. I wanted to share those with you today. This is a summary of what he said.

"This is my first time on the mission trip. I get to talk with so many special people because in China we don't have this opportunity to talk with this kind of people because they are in prison. Also, they are addicted to drugs. In the kitchen I have studied so many kinds of skills. One of the best for me (on the mission) was learning how to cut the turkeys. It is not common for us to see turkeys in China, especially in the restaurant or the super market. So I never saw it and this is the first time I cut it....So a guy comes and asks me if I want to cut turkeys. What did you say? What? I never touched it (before). So I work with Jeremy and it was very fun. Finally, I appreciate this opportunity to go to California to work with my friends. I understand this sentence deeply (from the BARM logo): 'Changing Lives for a Brighter Tomorrow'. I think this is a wonderful sentence. Also, I appreciate that God can teach them and educate them to be good people. In China, we don't have these organizations to teach some special things for them. We just let them go after prison. Also they will do some bad things again. They will go to prison again. It is very bad. So I appreciate what they do here."
