



Gregg's Good News

There are various ideas about how a church should proceed when looking for a new staff member. But, general agreement is that early in the process a congregation must spend time understanding who they are and who they believe God wants them to be. If I pose the question to you: "Who is this congregation?" what would you say? Here are a few answers I suggest.

- 1. We are a congregation with a high belief in the value and authority of the Bible. When we are looking for answers, Scripture is honored. Having said that, we could do a better job of allowing the word of God to trump each human preference and opinion as we try to choose what to do. "Who might be upset if we do this?" is not the best decision criteria.
- 2. We are a congregation that values members belonging together like a family rather than seeing ourselves as individuals who relate to God but don't want to relate to one another. That conviction shows itself in conversation before and after our meetings, and willingness to help each other with meals during times of sickness or adversity. An over emphasis on "everyone being as close as my best friend or favorite sister" can result in frustration as the church adds new members. Others voice an annoyance with the existence of sub-groups, forgetting that it is not feasible to be best friends with 150 people.
- 3. We are a congregation that has an increasing number of people from other countries participating in our Sunday morning assembly and other congregational activities. I am glad that you are doing a good job of welcoming our new friends. It will be important that we continue to help all people know God. And that we make room for new people from every nation to serve in every aspect of the church.
