If I were singing the song this morning, my lament would focus on a different loss. This is the second day that Comcast's national phone system has been dysfunctional. Generally, people have been able to call into the church building, but anytime we try to call out, a loud busy signal is all we get.

I mention this so you will give grace to us in the church office who haven't been able to call you. But I also mention the phone outage because it exemplifies "you don't know what you've got 'til it's gone". I don't realize how dependent I am on being able to communicate over the land line until I can't.

Now, let's play pretend. Pretend with me that church was no longer available. There will never again be an opportunity to be with these people whose lives are woven into yours. There will never again be an opportunity to sing with them, pray with them, share Communion with them, pool your resources with them, or contemplate Scripture with them. No potluck lunches. No singing together in the park.

When it comes to our shared life in the church, we take it for granted. The church will always be there when I need it. Stopping by to be with the body once every 3 or 4 weeks, neglecting to serve any purpose for other people in the body, coming in late and leaving early, ignoring invitations to connect with others away from Sunday morning. All those choices take a toll. Enough of a toll that one day, they could bulldoze this building and put up a parking lot. Why? Because the church has already evaporated. We can get by without phone service. Will we get by without us?
