Gregg's Good News

Our hearts go out to the Kent/Parsons family. Jackie's nephew, Lance Hill, died accidentally last Sunday. That event, coupled with my preparation for his funeral, reminded me again that none of us know when our lives are going to end.

Given the reality that the moment your life is going to be over can't be forecast, the stance to take is "always prepared." In other words, rather than planning to get ready for judgment just before your life is over, get ready now and stay ready. That way, you don't have to worry about the end of your life and Jesus' 2nd coming.

As Jesus was speaking with his disciples about the destruction of the temple, he also spoke of the ultimate end of time. Consider Mark 13:33-37

³³ Be on guard! Be alert! You do not know when that time will come. ³⁴ It's like a man going away: He leaves his house and puts his servants in charge, each with their assigned task, and tells the one at the door to keep watch.

³⁵ "Therefore keep watch because you do not know when the owner of the house will come back—whether in the evening, or at midnight, or when the rooster crows, or at dawn. ³⁶ If he comes suddenly, do not let him find you sleeping. ³⁷ What I say to you, I say to everyone: 'Watch!'"

Weeks like this prompt reflection. I implore you to consider the following thoughts.

- 1. Are you prepared to stand before God in final judgment?
- 2. If you are not prepared, what is the obstacle that prevents you from getting right with God?
- 3. Do you need someone to help you take the steps? (If so, any church leader is willing to help you.)

II Cor. 5:2 "I tell you, now is the time of God's favor, now is the day of salvation."
