# Gregg's **Good News**

One important aspect of being a church leader is mentioned at Eph. 4:12, "to prepare God's people for works of service." The easiest way I know to do that is by having a person with me as I do ministry. Since I don't have all of you with me all the time, I offer the following principles and story.

One aspect of Christian service is evangelism. You have heard me say, "Success is Sowing." For me, that means every time I choose to go ahead and say a gospel word, do a service in Jesus' name, or somehow make God known—that is a moment of success. I cannot control the response from people. I can only control whether I do the "Jesus thing." And when I do, I choose to view it as success.

As a corollary to that thought, I've shaped my activity around another practice. "The more people I talk to, and the longer I talk, the greater the probability I can put in a good word for Jesus.'

Lately, I've discovered that many people will converse with me if I mention their tattoos. It easily moves to talking about what the art means to that person, which often opens the door for me to do some sowing. So, until I make the language catchier, I'll add the principle: "Talk to people about their tattoos."

I was buying gasoline recently. As I was washing my window, I said to the young woman assisting me, "I really like that cross tattoo you have." After she acknowledged my appreciation, I continued, "Do you have a church that you are involved with?" She replied, "Not since I've gotten to Corvallis." That created the open door for me to say, "Well, I am with Church of Christ, corner of Kings and Circle. You would always be welcome there." She smiled and thanked me.
