Hurricane Florence is bearing down on the coast of North and South Carolina. For days, authorities have called on people to evacuate inland so that they won't be in danger from winds, storm surge and flooding. Unlike our familiar Oregon coast, there is little elevation change from the ocean as one moves inland. Consequently, a large area is expected to suffer from the effects of the storm.

Yet the same pattern we've observed in many recent hurricanes persists. Some people refuse to heed the warning. The reasons they offer for riding out the storm in place vary. Some seem more reasonable than others, like the family who said "We don't have money for a hotel and I have an immune system that is compromised. I'm afraid I will get very sick if I stay in a shelter."


But the fact remains. Warning of a serious reality is being issued. Yet some people refuse to take the action the warning is intended to prompt.

Luke 14 records Jesus' parable of a banquet. The parable carries an undercurrent of how God invites people to his great banquet at judgment—but many ignore the warning even though the element of danger is imminent.

Standard practice was to invite people in advance. Then they would be notified later when the banquet was imminent. In the parable, many made excuses that don't seem appropriate. As a result, the master responds, "not one of those men who were invited will get a taste of my banquet."

A hurricane is coming, but I'll refuse the order to get to safety. Judgment is coming but I'll refuse the invitation to get ready. Why are some people so stubborn? What good is it to gain the whole world but lose your soul?
