Gregg's Good News

The Barna group does social research concerning attitudes and actions transpiring in the broader church. Their research reveals that one-half of U.S. churchgoers have not heard of "the Great Commission". When shown Scripture passages, 37% could not identify what passage went by that name.

In case it is unfamiliar to you, here is a snip from Matt. 28:16-20. ¹⁹Therefore **go and make disciples of all** nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you.

Barna's research found most all practicing Christians believe that part of faith means being a witness of Jesus. Almost all said that the best thing that could happen to a person is for them to know Jesus. Of the various age groups, Millennials feel best equipped to share the faith.

But about half of that age group have internalized an obstacle that our culture continually reinforces: it is wrong to share one's personal beliefs with someone of a different faith in hopes that they will one day share the same faith.

Over the years, I have viewed trying to bring God into as many conversations as possible a major aspect of the adventure of life. In the process, I have discovered that carefully listening first is crucial. But so is believing that it is worth it to "step across the line" even in contemporary culture.

Perhaps we need to reframe the question: "Is it worse for a person to potentially be annoved because I share my faith OR is it worse for that person to experience eternal separation from God?
