## Gregg's Good News

Notre Dame cathedral was damaged by fire on Monday. The news was met with sadness from people who love the city of Paris, fans of the Gothic architecture, and many people of faith. Responses have included the pledge from French President Macron to rebuild the edifice in 5 years and huge pledges of cash from rich people.

Granted, I have never entered this particular cathedral, but the level of intense feeling generated across a broad range of the Euro-American populace catches me by surprise. I understand Notre Dame is a place to observe the architectural wonder of "flying buttresses". The building's fame is recalled every time we read or watch "The Hunchback of Notre Dame". And anything over 8 centuries old is noteworthy.

But I find the outcry and sadness over damage to a building is deafening compared to the outcry and sadness over the loss of Christian belief in the life of so many Europeans. It betrays the danger of allowing symbols of Christianity to take the place of practicing the faith itself.

While we wish we knew exactly where Joseph's tomb that Jesus borrowed was located—I fear pilgrims would prize the tomb more than the Messiah who left it behind. I fear there would be more sadness over damage to the stone structure than intention to imitate the Risen One. On this Sunday referred to as Easter, the day has become a monument that replaces the need to live Christian daily for too many folks.

Eph. 2:22 reminds us "And in him you too are being built together to become a dwelling in which God lives by his Spirit." So, go ahead and grieve Notre Dame if that makes sense to you. But beyond that—live the life of the Risen One and become a building suitable for God to truly inhabit.
