Gregg's **Good News**

I remember watching a game show on TV when I was a child. A family with 16 children was introduced. But it wasn't the size of the family that intrigued me. It was the answer each child gave to the question: "What do you want to do when you grow up?" Every boy responded, "I want to be a priest." Every girl responded, "I want to be a nun."

I didn't really know what all it meant to be a priest or a nun. But I understood that each child wanted to serve God in a very deliberate way. In later years, I've been curious what was communicated in that family to prompt every child to enter a formal Christian vocation.

At my stage of life, I am aware that people can be full-on servants of God in all manner of workplaces. But I also note a tendency for fewer young men to enter the task of full-time church ministry.

I know that our society gives less respect to "clergy" folks. In part, sinful and foolish actions by TV preachers and personalities has created unfortunately deserved backlash against religious figures.

But I wonder if it reveals the need for an emphasis in Christian homes. I'm thinking more broadly than statements from parents like, "It wouldn't be the worst thing in the world for you to be a missionary". Rather, an emphasis on family members doing Christian church life and service together.

For example: Our evening meeting tonight is designed for people to serve together. And the most important outcome might not be the work accomplished. Bigger than that is the opportunity for children to do ministry. With wisely chosen words, "Wasn't it good to serve God together tonight?" we just might raise up a generation who desires to serve God wholeheartedly as church members, ministers or missionaries.
