Gregg's Good News

Imagine that you are one of the disciples who witnessed Christ during those 40 days after his resurrection. One day you watch as Jesus ascends to heaven. You know he told you to wait in Jerusalem for the Holy Spirit, then be witnesses to the ends of the earth. Two angels reminded you that one day Jesus would return in the same way he ascended. But even with that information, it is easy to imagine the disciples looked at each other with the same question in mind. "We have the big picture, but *now what do we do*?"

On Easter Sunday, the invitation was for all of us to live a life that shows "Jesus is risen" everywhere, all the time. It wouldn't be surprising if that invitation leaves you wondering, "We have the big picture, but *what does God expect new life to look like?*" Currently, Thomas and I are focusing the preaching in the direction of fleshing out the implications of what the resurrected life looks like.

Last week I explored the idea of "Social Justice." I invited you to consider the heart of God and the way that he chooses to bless people. Allowing the heart of God to inform your thinking to be faithful and your actions to be faithful is one component of living "Jesus is risen" on a daily basis.

This morning, Thomas will lead us in expressing the life of the Risen Lord in our assembly of worship. Don't be surprised if the experience he points us towards also calls us to giving both thinking and actions over to honoring God.
