# Thomas' Takeaways

In the first week of June I headed back to South Dakota to repair our house from water damage. I opted to take an Uber car from the airport to the car rental agency, and I'd like to tell you about my driver for that ride, Frehiwot. Frehiwot is from Ethiopia. She'd been in the Denver area for almost 6 years, and was ecstatic about her job with Uber, with which she was able to support herself and her mother. She said the best thing was that it was so incredibly easy to find that job and she makes "a ton and tons" more money than she would in Ethiopia. When I asked her how often she worked, it equated to about a 30 hour/week job. She told me that resources and jobs like Uber in her home country were scarce, and that it was much easier to have a better quality of life here.

Don't read this as an "American Dream" story, because my point isn't even about Frehiwot, America, or jobs, but perspective. This young lady was ecstatic about a job and place which I might be tempted to complain about if that was "all" I had. How many of us would call driving 30 hours a week for Uber a last resort? Yet, this job meets her needs and she is grateful, and incredibly excited to share her experience.

I started thinking about how that relates to our congregation, and how often we start taking the familiar for granted and complain. How many people would love to have the community and fellowship we enjoy on a regular basis? How many people long to hear about the hope and love that is proclaimed form Scripture? How many people don't have a community to turn to for needs or prayers as we do here?

Are we perfect? No. But we are blessed. Blessed to have Christ as our head, each other as brothers and sisters, and a church family to call our own. I pray that each one of us may be as excited and grateful about our congregation and the God we serve as Frehiwot is about her part-time job. Her smile and enthusiasm was contagious. Ours ought to be too.
