Thomas' Takeaways

For many decades, the average tenure of a preacher in the United States was 2.5-3.5 years. A recent study by Lifeway & Gladstone has found the average tenure has doubled to 6 years since 1996, and I'll call that a good thing for the church overall. Having said that, let me throw some other research at you:

- 1500 clergy per month leave the ministry due to burnout
- Nearly 50% of ministers' marriages end in divorce
- 70% of ministers fight depression
- 60-80% of ministers will not be in ministry in 10 years

I say all that not to have you pity those who serve in Ministry, but for you to recognize what a gift and blessing Gregg & Pam Strawn have been at Circle, and indeed what a rarity they are in ministry. I need not tell many of you of the ways they have impacted many here, how Gregg has been God's faithful speaker for so many Sundays, or how their tireless devotion to Circle through their devotion to Christ has left its mark. Few churches are blessed to have a couple like Gregg & Pam, who have been able to navigate not only life with their faith and family intact, but through the ups and downs of ministering to their community and church family for so long.

Even as all of us are excited for the future and the upcoming 'official' transition of Gregg's retirement, I encourage you to stop and reflect on the rare and wonderful presence they have been and are to Circle, and praise God for how we all have been blessed to have their steadfastness and devotion to God's work. Even as you continue to embrace and encourage my family, I pray you stop and intentionally let Gregg and Pam know your appreciation and gratefulness of their work and life from the last 38 years. Even though they will still be around Circle post-July, couples like Gregg & Pam are quickly disappearing in ministry. Let us take every opportunity to treasure them and praise God for who they are, what they have meant to us, and for how God has and yet will use their lives for His glory.
