# Gregg's Good News

Some of you are familiar with phrases that I often use. It is a succinct way of helping a point stick with us, even though it doesn't cover all the bases. Just in case you missed the meaning, let me explain.

***“Success Is Sowing”*** I Cor. 3:6 captures Paul’s philosophy of evangelism. “I planted the seed, Apollos watered it, but God made it grow.” It is easy to become discouraged as an evangelist if the only moment to feel success is a baptism. I find it motivating to count it success every time I do a simple service in Jesus’ name or put in a word for Him. I cannot control the response of other people, but I can control if I act as a seed planter and waterer. And when I do, I trust God to grow the seed.

***“Every Member On Mission Every Moment”*** I Cor. 12 elaborates the fact that every Christian is gifted. I Peter 2:5 describes all Christians as priests. It is a healthy habit to continually walk through life imitating Christ; always looking for opportunities to speak and act in ways that glorify God.

***“Success Is Sending”*** Jesus sets the example of sending disciples at various moments. Matt. 28:19 is one of those sending moments. As a congregation with Campus Ministry and high turnover of people, it is better to celebrate as God’s people move to continue the mission elsewhere than to only grieve their departure.

***“Changing the World by Communicating Christ: From Corvallis to the Continents”*** As a child, I remember church leaders envisioning a time when people from around the world would come to study at OSU. And we would help them come to know Christ. As we look at a map of the world 50+ years later, we’re reminded of people on 6 continents who were shaped by life with a small congregation in Corvallis, Oregon. And the joy of world changing continues.
