# Thomas' Takeaways

Today we welcome Milton Jones from Christian Relief Fund, and we praise God for not only his and CRF's efforts, but also for your generosity in being able to contribute to building a fourth well. It should go without saying, but clean water is a literally life-giving necessity, and the impact of a community gaining fresh water will be felt for generations to come. Thank you, Circle.

I grew up with a well, and I didn't realize there was such a thing as 'city water' until I was in double-digits, though I knew that the water from my grandparents' house just tasted weird. We had a reliable well, it only got low once, and while it never dried up, I remember the adjustments we had to make and worry about what would happen if it were to. This is the closest I've ever come to not having water, and even then, Walmart was just a 15-minute drive away.

I do wonder how people's spiritual wells are doing at any given moment. I wonder how many people have never actually had a full spiritual well to begin with, and how many peoples' have dried up over the years, with spiritual dirt or md being the best thing they have. You can't help but think of John 4, where the woman was drawing water from a physical well, which was and is supremely needed, yet her spiritual well was dry and could only be replenished by Jesus.

We shall pray that the well CRF builds will impact and sustain many people, but let us also pray that each of us have and live out lives replenished and sustained by the deep wells of living water in Jesus Christ, that turn life to life eternal. Many people in our community, who have never known a lack of physical water, are desperately thirsty for true life. What a blessing to be able to show the world both!
