#### Relevancy

"[The Bible] is inherently and unfailingly relevant. Our task as teachers of the Bible is not to make it relevant, as if we could, but rather by explaining it and applying it, the text that is, we have the privilege of showing how relevant it actually is." -Alistair Begg

I came across this quote this week from Begg's two-part lecture on Ecclesiastes (I'm still working through it, but I'd already recommend it, and be happy to share it with you.) It struck me because there are many conversations addressing the very issue of how to make the Bible relevant, especially to younger people. Begg's point is that to ask that question means you're already off kilter. The better question is how best to **show** the Bible's relevancy to, in, and through our lives.

I was thinking of this quote Wednesday night as we set up the clothing giveaway tents and racks. The clothing giveaway is a big thing that does indeed take time and energy. It's easy to lose why we do it considering the stress it brings, never-ending bags and constant need for upkeep, yet the why has never been more important.

The clothing giveaway is to take care of those in need in the name of Christ, the very Christ that Scripture speaks of, in whom there is true, eternal life. The giveaway is part of that privilege by which we show that Scripture is relevant, that whom Scripture speaks of is the most relevant figure in history.

Hopefully this encourages you as it does me, that we don't work in the clothing drive just for clothes or because we do every year, but the giveaway is indeed part of the proclaiming of Christ, and why He is needed in this world. It shows, like our whole life should, what happens when a group of people decide service in His name is worth their time and effort. What a relevant lesson for this world. Grace to you.
