What We're Known For

Since I've been here, I've tried to make it a point to not only get to know you all in the congregation but get to know the area as well. I've met with various organizations and ministry leaders across the cities, as well as used the opportunity to tell others I'm the new guy at Circle Church of Christ. If they ask where that is, I'll tell them Circle and Kings, and follow up with "The church that gives away clothes every year." 99% of the time (the 1% being usually younger people) they respond, "Oh right, I know the clothing giveaway church!" About half the time, however, I don't need to explain as people recognize Circle as the free clothes church. None of this probably comes as a surprise to many of us, I'm sure.

Christ said His followers would be known by their fruit and their love for one another (Matthew 7:16 & John 13:35). That love and fruit manifested in giving away clothes isn't a bad reputation; indeed, many churches would love to positively be known as "The church that..." As much energy as it takes, the giveaway is a good thing.

I'd much rather be known as the "church that loves" or "the church that looks like Christ" than ONLY "the church that gives clothes."
