I love my office here at Circle. With the attached bathroom and the newly added coffee station, it has ALMOST everything I need (A refrigerator would make it absolutely perfect). I love the natural light from the wall of windows, it makes it so easy to read my Bible and study and prepare for my sermons. Plus, there is something about walking into the church building every day that gets me in the mood to spend time with God. But, sometimes, I feel a deep connection with God when I am not at the building.

I enjoy coffee, and I really enjoy reading my Bible at a coffee shop. My office is super quiet, and a great place to do an intensive study, or to prepare notes, but when I read in a social setting, like a coffee shop, I have a totally different experience with God while I am reading my Bible. Not to mention the added benefit the coffee shop offers of interacting with people who see me reading my Bible and initiate a conversation.

Sometimes, I have noticed, I don't even have to go anywhere to connect with God. I have young children, and occasionally they will wake up in the middle of the night and it will take a while for them to go back to sleep. While I am lying down with them waiting for them to fall asleep, I can take advantage of some prayer time by praying for the kids as they grow up. A dark house at 2 in the morning offers a quiet place to pray and meditate.
