The Value of Good Questions

How many times have you been asked this morning, "How are you?" No, really, how many times? Now, how many times have you answered some of "Great...fine...good...how are you?" and then gotten the same response? Probably at least a few. Is there anything wrong with this interaction? No, but let's be honest - in our society today "How are you?" has become a nicety, not an actual question. It's become a greeting, not an inquiry. From personal experience, it's a question that most people don't expect a real answer to. Now realize, for many people in gathered situations, that's the extent of their interaction with most people. Including church.

The blunt question is $\underline{\mathbf{do}}$ you care about how the person next to you is doing, or are you simply greeting them? If you thought that was blunt: many people aren't sure of that answer, from either side. "Do I have time to have a real conversation before assembly starts?" "Does anyone really have time to listen to my stresses from this week...whoops, Bible class is starting." You may not think about it in exactly that way, but the sentiment may be there.

People are desperate authentic relationships and communities, and desperate for people who really care about them. Philippians 2:3-4 tells us to count the others as more important than ourselves. We know this, but do we act like it? I would wonder the affect of simply changing how we greet people, and instead of just greeting them, letting them know and inviting them to truly share how they are, whatever comes out. Are we willing to bear each others' burdens, to pray with one another in the foyer, and to allow true relationships to form, even if it means we're late to Bible Class?


