The Youngest in Creation



Sunday our 5th child, and 3rd daughter, was born. Melissa Grace Pruett has made herself right at home in the world, in our home, and in our lives. It's a wonderful experience that even after a few times is full of excitement, wonder, and reflection.

One of the things that I often think about when I see or hear about newborns, and particularly my own children, is a thought that lingers and I just can't really, truly believe. When I watched Melissa enter this world, for that fraction of an instant, she was the youngest in creation. Younger than any baby, fawn, kitten – she was the youngest in all the world.



At one point in time, many years ago, in a small town called Bethlehem, Jesus was born. And for a second in time, Christ, God incarnate, was the youngest in His own creation. I admit I have a hard time conceiving of Jesus being that small, tiny, and helpless, when I know what He would do for us 30 years later. That He would truly become like us so we could truly become like Him – saved by grace and renewed by His blood into innocence. Like the baby being born right now who is youngest in creation. Like Melissa was. Like Jesus was. Grace to you.
