## Thomas' **Takeaways**

#### The Gift of Prayer

If you haven't heard, in a few days it will be 2020 even for us who have heard that, it still seems crazy! A new year is bright and fresh with possibilities, the promise of time yet unspent, opportunities yet untaken, and blessings yet unfound. Some are frightened by the uncertain, but I invite all of us to realize that God is already there, and this new year is full of chances to meet Him in His work!

Part of God's work is the act of prayer. All over Scripture are we commanded, implored, and encouraged to pray and pray for one another (James 5:16, Eph 6:18, 1st Thess. 5:16-18, Romans 8:26, Colossians 4:2, just to name a few...there are more...) and this is an act the church should take exceedingly seriously. We should take it seriously both in our personal walk with God, but just as seriously to pray for those who are in our blood and church families. Many of us do – I was blessed with a card with the names of all the children in the congregation for whom I pray regularly – but I want to challenge us to take it one step further, and I'll start with a story.

Many moons ago when I interviewed here (ok, it was less than a year, but how often do you get to start a story like that?) many positive things struck me about Circle, but one that made an impression that, regardless of how the interview went, would stay with me was that over four days, I and my family were prayed for on the spot at least six times, in addition to the prayers offered for us Sunday morning. That mattered to me in that it showed the people here were interested in our family in a Kingdom way, not just in a job way. It mattered because it meant people were truly listening to us, and their faith in God was such that it wasn't an interruption, but a natural reaction to stop and pray at that moment. I came home from an interview spiritually refreshed in fellowship from people I'd never met before. That's a rarity indeed.

I ask you if that story would ring true for you for someone who's not a ministerial candidate today. How often do we not only pray for someone, but pray for them right then in front of them? Discomfort can be mitigated with practice, but we must choose to give such a gift. Let us ring in this new year by committing to give a gift beyond our ability - commending the people in front of us to God and His power, here and now. Let's start today. Grace to you.
