Spiritual Resolutions

On Thursday, I went to my latest go-to place for lunch (thanks Ryan Bracht...he knows why) and had what some would say is a negative experience. As such, I'll not be naming the specific place, but the usual meal is a delicious take on a taco salad.

First, the server never made eye contact with me, which I notice. Then, they skipped over several ingredients that usually come with it which I had to ask for and were put in sparingly. When asked, "Queso, salsa, sour cream or cheese?" I responded with "Mild, corn, yes and yes," to which they skipped the queso, put on the wrong salsa, and put on the skimpiest bit of cream and cheese. They started to put on the lid when I asked for two additional ingredients and with a sigh, they appeased me. I said thank you, but they had already moved on to another customer. I myself was quite pressed for time, so though now underwhelmed with my lunch, I paid and left.

What are YOU thinking about this experience? What are YOUR thoughts on the server? Many people would begin to think of descriptions - lazy, unfocused, rude, uncaring. And that would be a mistake on our part. What we'd be doing is called Fundamental Attribution Error, and it happens when we assume someone's character based on their actions in a present moment, while we often will only judge our own actions by our intentions. This is the same thing as calling someone who runs a just-changed red light a jerk but, when it happens to you, justifying it by any number of reasons.

I have no idea what this server's day, week, month, year, or life is and has been like. What could happen just this morning that would affect YOUR day? Here's my point: Philippians 2 calls us to put others' interests above our own, as Christ did for us. Thus, while my salad was a little less delicious than usual, sometimes putting others' interests above your own simply means to give them the benefit of the doubt in your own head and heart. This year, I challenge us to be aware of this, particularly in the church, so that no member or visitor who comes into our presence will walk away underwhelmed with who God and Jesus are. A person's relationship with God ain't just a taco salad, after all. Grace to you.
