Thomas' Takeaways

“Just Out Of Beauty School”

I got my hair cut this morning. I go over to SuperCuts, mainly because that was just the first place I went and on a few certain things, I tend to be a creature of habit. Erica, the store manager, cut my hair, and she did a marvelous job, so if anyone is looking for a new stylist, I'd recommend her.

In the course of talking, because what else do you do when you're sitting there watching your hair fall to the floor, we talked about a great many things (you can imagine I enjoy talkative stylists)—family, work, school, kids, many things. One of the things that really stuck with me, and inspired this article, was when she was talking about the experience gap between new hires right out of beauty school and the 'real world' variety of haircuts that are required out of the store. "They have a foundation, but there are things you just don't do in beauty school that you have to learn as you go. I'm here to step in if they mess up, but they really learn how to cut all sorts of hair on the job, in or out of school," she said. I couldn't help but think about how Christianity is pretty much the same. We study, hopefully on our own as well as in class, learn from the sermon, discuss it in small groups, some of us may even read theology commentaries or scholarly books. But do we realize that that is the 'beauty school' of being a Christian? Where we really learn to be like Christ is not solely when we learn, but when we are interacting with people, and faced with the choices to put into practice what we've learned, some of which study alone doesn't prepare us for. But we learn, on our foundation of Christ.

I also caught discipleship in the salon's approach—someone less experienced works with the more experienced stylist close by. Not only must we learn on the job, as it were, but do we make room for those new or less mature in Christ to learn? Do we let them stretch themselves, doing things they've never done before? Do we let them fail? Do we really let those younger than us, in faith or age, grow, or do we perhaps unintentionally keep them in school?

Christianity is more important than hair (no offense Erica), but does the church do well at bringing people from beauty school to real life? Or are we comfortable learning without ever taking a snip at really living like Christ in ways we haven't before? A stylist who never brandishes scissors but knows how isn't the most useful. I'll take one who messed up now and then but is trying to live out what they know. I think Christ would too. Grace to you.

I now realize my stupidity. Paul says that husbands should “love their wives just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her to make her holy” (Eph 6:25-26), and that is the same sacrifice we celebrate at the Lord’s Table every Sunday. Both the Communion Table and the Marriage Alter are Holy reminders of the sacrificial love of Christ and the union he shares with his people. In fact, “In Remembrance Of Me” could be inscribed on any table, chair or building because the sacrifice of Christ is written on our hearts (2 Cor. 4:11). “And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him” (Col. 1:17).
