I Can't Do It

So yesterday (in writing this on Monday February 10th), as sometimes happens in the life of young kids, Mitchell had an incident that resulted in a lovely addition of three stitches in his chin. He did a wonderful job in the emergency room, even though it was understandably scary, for him as well as Mom and Dad! The nurses came in, looked at it, and after quickly calling Amy we did indeed decide the best course of action was putting a few stitches in to make sure it closed and healed the best it could in an awkward place.

While I explained to Mitchell what was going to happen, he understandably got a bit frightened. He had no context or prior experience with what was going on. He knew he was hurt and hurting, and we had just told him there'd be a little more pain (getting a shot of local anesthetic) before things would get better. There was even a moment of him telling me, "I can't do this!" to which I replied, "This is the best thing for you right now. Do you trust me?" He nodded. "This is the best thing to get you fixed up," I told him.

It hurt my heart as a father to have to look my son in the eye and tell him that there would be more pain before things get better. It hurt my heart to see him scared. It hurt my heart that he was hurt at all! But I was proud of how he handled it in the end, and we were all relieved when it was done.

No matter how many times I have these experiences as a father to my own children, I still sometimes struggle to trust God when I'm in pain in my own life. As no one is to blame for the accident leading to Mitchell needing stitches, often our own pain isn't caused by anyone or anything we can blame, but it happens. Often, I want to tell God, "I can't do this!" and sometimes I do tell him. We can't always know why or what will happen during our times of pain. And honestly, unlike going to the doctor, sometimes we can't be sure it'll be the best thing for us. But I do know two things: that God can and does use whatever we go through to make us more like Him. And, He tells us the same thing I told Mitchell all through the ER—"I'm with you. And I love you." As Mitchell grabbed my hand, and as I often blindly grasp for God in the darkness when I can't do it, sometimes that's enough. Grace to you.
