...For The Good Of Those Who Love Him...

It's beyond our purview to say whether God did or did not cause this pandemic. We're not biblical prophets, and I at least have not seen anyone be able to biblically prove that their insights came directly from God. So while we can't answer all those why's, we can have some thoughts about the what's that are in front of us, and how they impact the why's we can answer.

This week, I invite you to reflect on a few of these questions, if you haven't already. Pray about where the Spirit may guide you in your reflection, and for how they may impact the future of your life, your walk with God, and the church.

- What have you learned during the last few months that you may not have otherwise learned about God, about the church, or about fellowship?
- What do you miss most about assembling in person?
- What do you like most about streaming services at home?
- What are some things, based on this experience, that could be different about meeting together in person for the better?
