

The Thing and Rumors of the Thing

This week I was reading Matthew and a verse in chapter 24 stuck out ever so slightly; I put a note on it. But listening to a podcast a day later the same verse was referenced and stuck out to me in a whole new way. In Matthew 24 Jesus is asked about the signs of His coming and the end of the age, and he responds with, "Watch out that no one deceives you. For many will come in my name, claiming, 'I am the Messiah,' and will deceive many. You will hear of wars and rumors of wars, but see to it that you are not alarmed. Such things must happen, but the end is still to come" (vss. 4b-6).

Two things stick out to me: Jesus says not to be taken with what you hear of wars or even rumors of wars – **rumors**. As in, "Hey did you hear what *MIGHT* be true? Did you hear that *MAYBE* this is happening?" The second thing that stands out is what Jesus says how to respond to it: do not be alarmed.

So much of our world today is designed to cause alarm – from news media sensationalizing political reports, to the (terrible) interpretations of the same end times events Jesus was asked about, to polarizing and politicizing the mental, physi8cal, & emotional health of fellow humans.

Luke 21:34 adds another caution: be careful, or your hearts will be weighed down. I don't know about you, but 'normal' life has enough ups and downs to cause alarm and weigh my heart down without me purposely adding the alarm and weight of news reports & politics. And I definitely don't need to add those things to the people around me, as I'm not sure how alarmed or weighed down they already are.

My point is this, brothers and sisters: be aware of the state of your heart, and if what you're inviting in is causing alarm or putting weight not only on your heart, but on those around you. Jesus cautioned not to get caught up in those things – we'd do well to still heed His words. Grace to you.
