Thomas' Takeaways

Turning Around

Last October I spent 3 days in the backcountry hiking around in the Rogue-Umpqua Divide Wilderness, west of Crater Lake. I was supposed to spend 5 days, but I forgot the charging cord for my Garmin inReach, and I wasn't about to meander around all by myself with no way to contact anyone! It was a great experience – mountain summits over 6000 feet, beautiful forests, trickling streams, cool at night, mild days – I look forward to my next backcountry adventure.

There are trails in these wildernesses that are somewhat maintained – the Forest service, I think, does an impressive job keeping the thousands of miles of trails as maintained as they do. Foot traffic helps keep these trails obvious, but sometimes they can hinder you too.

Especially on switchbacks, I found that I quite often would look ahead and see the trail continue to go straight, but suddenly, as I hiked, the trail would suddenly end. I would look around, but as I looked behind me it would be glaringly obvious that I had overshot the *real* trail, as had others, and had to turn around. What struck me was that the false trail was so well defined that you often had to walk past the real trail to turn around and see it, as while it was difficult to see the turn on the trail it was amazingly obvious once you were past the turn. This was a constant trend, though I eventually got the hang of identifying these false trails, and I'd turn around to find the real trail much sooner.

In the walk of faith, many Christians are afraid of making wrong turns or walking past what they believe is "God's will," so they don't walk, or they wait for someone to guide them, who may or may not come along or even be helpful. I had a map & a GPS and STILL overshot the trails, and real life is much more complicated than a physical trail. What I believe is important is that Christians keep walking toward the goal, realizing that sometimes, yes, we'll either make the wrong turn or walk right past something. But Christ never condemns those who try in faith and get it wrong. He only condemns those who never try to walk OR who think that they are on the right path, and no one will tell them otherwise. In faith, it's always better to have to turn around than to never start or not continue – sometimes those wrong turns tell us more than the right ones do. So, keep walking Christian, keep your eyes on Christ, and bring your charging cord! Grace to you.
