Thomas' Takeaways

Father's Day

Like Mother's Day, often I like to preface anything said about this day by acknowledging that this is also not a happy day for everyone. In fact, this is probably less happy than Mother's Day. Consider these stats:

- 1 in 4 kids (25%) live without a father in the home
- 33% of children (24.7 million) live without the presence of their biological father
- 39% (17.7 million) of students in grades 1-12 live without the presence of their biological father
- 87.7% of post-war children grew up with 2 married parents in the home. As of 2012, 68.1% of children will grow up with that intact family (*2012, so I guarantee that's worse*)
- 63% of youth suicides are from fatherless homes (U.S. Dept. Of Health/Census) – 5 times the average.
- 90% of all homeless and runaway children are from fatherless homes – 32 times the average.
- 85% of all children who show behavior disorders come from fatherless homes – 20 times the average. (CDC)
- 80% of rapists with anger problems come from fatherless homes – 14x avg. (Justice & Behavior, Vol. 14, p. 403-26)
- 71% of all high school dropouts come from fatherless homes – 9x avg. (National Principals Association Report)

A well-known preacher in the Northeast, upon retiring from the ministry at 60 prayed daily for a new call upon his life. He started speaking, and in the Q & A session he quickly realized a large majority of those asking questions were young people, and they were seeking answers that usually would be asked of a father. He's made it the work of the rest of his life to be a father to young people. Such a calling would not be an unworthwhile work of the church, to show the world who THE Father, of love, grace, mercy, courage, and faith, is. Fatherlessness has been an epidemic long before COVID and will be for much longer. Let's start the cure today. Grace to you.
