


Thomas' **Takeaways**

Serve the Lord with reverential awe and rejoice with trembling" (Psalm 2:11, HCSB).

Psalm 2 presents the scarry side of God. He ridicules his enemies. He terrifies them with his wrath. He breaks them like an iron rod breaks pottery. His "anger may ignite at any moment" (Psalm 2:12 HCSB). The most interesting thing in this Psalm was the phrase "rejoice with trembling," How are we supposed to rejoice in God's presence when we are trembling? I think the answer lies in the last verse "All those who take refuge in Him are happy" (PS 2.12 HCSB). The image here is we (God's Children) are safe in his kingdom, protected. We have pledged our allegiance to him (2.12) and are his loyal subjects, safe behind his walls. We rejoice in the love and safety our God provides. However, we tremble as we look out on the battlefield and watch as he destroys the wicked. This also gives us an incentive to keep our covenant with him and stay within his kingdom. "The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and instruction" (Proverbs 1:7).
