A Note From Mark Johnson

Following God's Lead!

On Wednesday evenings we're doing a study called "Walking With God in the Desert". This past Wednesday we learned that the distance from Egypt to the Land of Canaan (Israel) is about 420 miles. For perspective, Oregon is 400 miles wide. Walking 10 miles a day it would take you 42 days to cover this distance, and yet it took the Israelites 40 years to complete this journey! Do you remember why it took them so long? You can read why in Numbers 13 & 14 and Joshua 5:4-6. We often describe this 40 year period as Israel "wandering" in the desert. Even though scripture also describes it as wandering (Numbers 32:13) they were not lost! In fact they were being led by God the whole time. "Remember how the Lord your God led you all the way in the wilderness these forty years..." Deuteronomy 8:2a. God provided food, clothing and shelter for them and guided them by day with a "pillar of cloud" and by night with a "pillar of fire" (Exodus 13:2). Life is like this for God's people. We know our final destination, but rarely do we know the path that we will follow to get there, but it's of upmost importance that we follow God's path! By following God's path, He will take care of us along the way and help us safely reach our destination; eternal life with Him! Jesus said to His disciples, "Come, follow me" (Matt. 4:19). We too must follow Him for this is the path that God has chosen for us to follow.
