II Corinthians 5:17-21

17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here! 18 All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: 19 that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation. 20 We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God. 21 God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

We are a family in need of reconciliation.

First, to God...Love God,

Second, to each other...Love your neighbor,

And Third, to all those who would hear the message, Go into all the world...

OUR mission IS reconciliation. We are to participate with God in repairing relationships. If there is anything I have witnessed in the last two years it is this: The devil is all about the destruction of relationships. He uses weapons of MASS destruction to ruin lives. In the form of gossip, mass media, partial truths, incomplete information, and the list goes on.
